### H. S. H. AMBASSADOR PRINCE STEFAN OF LIECHTENSTEIN

Prince Stefan of Liechtenstein was born on November 14, 1961 in Klagenfurt, Austria, as second son of H. S. H. Prince Alexander of Liechtenstein, one of the more distantly related cousins of His Serene Highness the Reigning Prince Hans-Adam II. He grew up on the family estate of Rosegg in Kärnten, Austria.

Prince Stefan attended the Primary School in Rosegg and the High School in Klagenfurt (1968 – 1980). Subsequently, he began his business administration studies at the University of Innsbruck, Tyrol, which he completed beginning of 1987 with the degree of Magister (mag. rer. soc. oec.). During this time he was a member of the association of Liechtenstein students in Tyrol. Following his studies he was involved in the reorganization of the family estate.

1988 – 1991 Union Bank of Switzerland (UBS) Zurich (trainee programme; later investment banking).

1991 – 1995 UBS Frankfurt, as director for new issues/investment banking.  
From 1995 to 2001 Prince Stefan led a tourism project on the family estate in Austria, together with his brother.

Prince Stefan is married to H. S. H. Princess Florentine of Liechtenstein, née Countess Thun – Hohenstein, who was born in Vienna, since 1988. The couple has four children.

From June 2001 to Summer 2007 Prince Stefan of Liechtenstein was the fourth ambassador of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the Swiss Confederation.

Since March 2007, he is the third extraordinary and plenipotentiary Ambassador of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the Federal Republic of Germany.
